### SNAPSHOTS OF BRANCH ACTIVITIES & EVENTS FOR SESSION 2011/2012

- 1.0 A total of 7 Branch Committee Meetings were held during the 2011/2012 Session. The Branch had its 43<sup>rd</sup> Annual General Meeting on the 25<sup>th</sup> June 2011 at Auditorium, Ultimate Professional Centre.Ir. Alan Tan Khiok Chun, MIEM, P.Eng. was elected as the new Branch Chairman for 2011/2012 session. A total of 105 members attended the meeting. The total membership of the brench is now at 1613.
- 2.0 The Branch reported that during the Session, it had actively organized the following activities:

#### 21rd February 2011

An International Seminar on: "Engineering a Sustainable Development: Role Played by Geotechnical Engineering" was organized in collaboration with IEM HQ at The Grand Margherita Hotel, Kuching. The invited Speakers are Prof. Dr. Chu Jian, Prof. Dr. Bujang Kim Huat, Dr. Leong KamWeng, Ir. Dr. Loke Kean Hooi, Ir. Albert Ho and Ir. Mark Wallace. The Seminar attracted 56 engineers.

### 1st March 2011

Seminar on: "Engineering Wonders with Steel" by SantanPathmanandavel was organised at the Branch's auditorium. SantanPathmanandavel shared his knowledge and insights of steel application for pre-engineered buildings, structural decking and lightweight trusses based on his vast experience in the subject matter. A total of 37 engineers attended the Seminar.

### 16th-17th March 2011

Cdr. (Rtd) Ir. Raymond Swa presented the BEM Mandatory Course on: "Engineering Management Practice" at the Auditorium, UPC. The Course was attended by 43 engineers from various disciplines.

### 31" March - 1" April 2011

Course on: "Fire Control Concepts & Design of Active Wet Systems" were held at Auditorium, UPC. The Course helps 20 participants to understand the Risk Management Process and Major causes of Fire Losses; the principles of combustion, fire behavior; identify the possible causes of fire and explosion (gas and dust) like static electricity.

### 9th - 10th May 2011

BEM Mandatory Course on: "Code of Ethics/Regulations" by Cdr (Rtd) Ir. Raymond Swa. The attendance recorded 39 engineers in this 2-day Course,

### 11th May 2011

Ir. Harbans KS Singh presented a 2-day Course on: "Payments & Variations in Engineering and Construction Contracts" to 53 engineers at Auditorium, UPC.

### 12th May 2011

Ir. Harbans KS Singh presented another course on: "Extension of Time and Damages in Engineering and Construction Contracts" at Auditorium, UPC. The Course was attended by 43 engineers.

### 25th June 2011

A Talk on "Duties & Responsibilities of the Padawan Municipal Council (PMC)" was presented by Cr. Ir. Lo Khere Chiang, who is also the Chairman of PMC. The Talk was also delived by Encik Abdul Razak Bin AbangBini. The Talk highlighted on the History of MPP (Profile MPP, Area of Jurisdicition), core functions & municipal development's current issues.

The 43th AGM of the Sarawak Branch was later on the same day with attendance recording at 105.

### 15th July 2011

The Sarawak Branch organized a One-Day Workshop on: "Malaysia National Annex to Eurocode 7 Geotechnical Design-Part 1: General Rules", organized by Geotechnical Engineering Technical Division, IEM HQ and proudly supported by Sirim, ACEM (Sarawak Branch) and the IEM (Sarawak Branch). Both Prof. Brian Simpson and Ir. Tan Yang Kheng delivered the Workshop to 46 participants.



This workshop explained the Principles and Application Rules given in Eurocode 7 and relevant National Annex and discussed how they should be interpreted and applied, and illustrated the impact of the new code by practical hands-on calculations in worked examples.

### 19th July 2011



Ir. Pick Eng Chong briefed 24 engineers on the recent developments in the laws and regulations which may affect the practices of the professional engineers as a result of the liberalization of the professional services including the engineering services in the trades and services with other

nations and promotion of other legislations within Malaysia, such

as the setting up of the Board of Technologists, Building Surveyors Act, and amendment of the Valuers' Act etc. The Dialogue titled "Recent Development in the Law & Practices" was held at Auditorium, UPC.



The Chairman and Committee of Sarawak Branch paid a courtesy call upon YAB Chief Minister of Sarawak on the development plan of proposed Sarawak International Engineering Centre.

### 23rd August 2011

The Sarawak Branch organized a Mini Workshop on: "Environmental Protection & Management in Sarawak" at Auditorium, UPC. The Workshop outlined:

- Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), Prescribe Order of the NREB and open burning activities by Mr Tsai Koh Fen.
- Post EIA monitoring and enforcement activities of the NREB by Environmental Control Officer, Mr Edmund MacMiller.
- Routine water, air and soil quality monitoring and solid waste management efforts of the NREB by Environmental Control Officer, Mdm Mary MagdalenLutok.
- Planning for measures and environmental projects by NREB and other stakeholders by Senior Environmental Control Officer, MsTang Hung Huong.
- Environmental Education and Awareness Programmes of the NREB by Environment Control Officer, MdmChristheMansom.

The Workshop received a good response, recording at 54 participants.

### 25th August 2011

The Branch organized a Seminar on: "Structural Concrete Repairs" with Sika Kimia Sdn Bhd. The presenters were Ir. Steven Ng Si Yoon &MrTohSengChee and they highlighted:

- Sika's experience in typical concrete repair (different structures);
- Sharing of selection criteria for the preferred concrete repair method;
- Water containing structures repair/maintenance;
- Strengthening of Structure with SikaCarbodur&SikaWrap systems;
- Typical concrete protective system for marine environment;
- Latest developments on repair materials & application methods;
- Case studies (above covering Grouting as well)
- Hydrophobic & Protection

### 13th - 15th September 2011

The purpose of this course "Distribution Substation Design" is to address the design issues of 33/11 kV distribution substations, particularly the open terminal type by bringing to focus the important factors in the selection of busbar configurations, layout of primary equipment, impact of transformers, circuit breaking & enclosure technology, lightning shielding, insulation coordination principles, protection and earthing. It attempts to answer questions such as "How are busbar configuration selected and designed?", "How does transformer neutral earthing impact insulation levels?", "What circuit breaking and enclosure technology is relevant?", "How does lightning shielding, transformer neutral earthing, and earthing impact insulation coordination?"

The course presenter was Ir. ThumPeng Chew and the Course was jointly organized with Sarawak Energy Berhad.

### 21" - 22" September 2011

BEM Mandatory Course on: "Safety & Health at Work" by Ir. Ahmad Nazri was held on Auditorium, UPC. This programme is specially designed in respect to the Code of Ethics in which engineers have to oblige. This is to ensure that the Engineering Professionalism in our country is enhanced and as competent as that of their counterpart globally. This programme will critically explain the role of 56 engineers in facing crucial situation at their workplace. Besides that, the programme will also touch on the most appropriate way of dealing with difficult scenario that arise at workplace which may have some conflicts of engineering ethical. Since the conflict of interests between organization and engineers varies from one to another, cases and facts from real job situation will be highlighted and discussed, which covers six elements of engineering aspects.

### 28th September 2011

Schneider Electric Industries (M) SdnBhd sponsored a Seminar on: "IEC 61439-1 Standards for Type-Tested Assemblies". IEC standards is a list of standards published by the International ElectrotechnicalCommission. The IEC is the world's leading organization that prepares and publishes International Standards for all electrical, electronic and related technologies, collectively known as electro technology. Wherever you find electricity and electronics, you find the IEC supporting safety and performance, the environment, electrical energy efficiency and renewable energies. The IEC also manages conformity assessment systems that certify that equipment, systems or components conform to its International Standards. This seminar will provide information about IEC 60439-1 standards for type-tested assemblies. IEC 61439-1 provides minimum requirements and test procedures for safe and reliable installation allowing a high availability of the electrical energy. The seminar will explain about the procedure that needs to go trough for type test as per IEC standards. The speaker was Mr Francis Wong, Business Development Manager Southeast Asia (Schneider Electric).

### 17th - 19th October 2011

This short course "Project Management Fundamentals" is intended mainly for the benefit of all engineers and other technical staff whose duties include working on, or managing projects, or who may be required to implement projects in their organizations, apart from their normal functional duties. The Speaker was Ir. Dr. Syed-Ahmad Fund Syed Abdul Hamid.

### 9th November 2011

This Seminar "Selecting Structural Decking as Preferred Construction Method" was held at the Riverside Majestic Hotel, Kuching with attendance of 69.

Structural decking is widely accepted as steel building profile sheeting in the construction industry. It is a highly economical, versatile and robust building material used to great effect on many major building projects and as well as countless small ones. It can be used as a formwork as well as a reinforcement system for composite concrete slab construction.

### 6th & 7th December 2011

Ir. Gary Lim EngHwa was invited to present a 2-day Course on: "Design of Sprinkler Systems - MS1910, NFPA13 and NFAPA15 Water Spray System" at the Sarawak Branch.

At the end of the training course, participants are highlighted to:

- Understand the history of sprinkler and it's development to modern time;
- Understand that a discount of 40% of insurance premium for sprinkler system installation allowed under PIAM guidelines;
- Know the types of sprinkler heads and its application;
- Understand the various sprinkler standards used in the industry, MSI910 and NFPA 13 and 15. The major differences between LPC rules and NFPA 13;
- Understand the various sprinkler systems available to meet certain situation or application;
- Apply the Fundamental of Fluid Dynamics on a case study to determine pipe size and pump capacity;
- Able to design Pre-Calculated System for Ordinary Hazard, High Hazard Storage and In-Rack Sprinkler systems; and
- Able to design Full Hydraulic calculation for Yard Transformers and LPG Refilling area.

### 30th November - 2nd December 2011

The Engineering Conference (EnCon) entitled "Advances and Innovation in Electrical, Electronics, Telecommunications, Computing & Engineering Technologies" were co-organized by the Faculty of Engineering, Unimas. The Conference held at Riverside Majestic Hotel, Kuching, Sarawak. The Engineering Conference (EnCon) is the flagship conference of the Faculty of Engineering. It has aimed to provide an avenue for researchers, scientists, engineers, academicians as well as industrial professionals to present their research results and development activities.

### 8th - 9th February 2012

Ir. Gary Lim presented a 2-day Course on: "Fire Control Concepts & Design of Active Wet Systems" and the topics covered were:

- Understand the Risk Management Process and Major causes of Fire Losses;
- Understand the principles of combustion, fire behavior;
- Identify the possible causes of fire and explosion (gas and dust) like static electricity;
- Minimize these causes and design of active wet systems in case to mitigate the potential losses:
- Understand the incentives provided by the insurance company for the installation of active wet systems, up to 70% discounts on the premium;
- Able to design fire pumps and pipe sizing of the wet systems (jockey and duty pump for hydrant ring main, wet riser, sprinkler);
- MS1910:2006 Fixed Firefighting systems Automatic Sprinkler Systems Design, Installation and Maintenance, able to design a Pre-Calculated Sprinkler system for Ordinary Hazard and selection of orifice plate;
- Understand the difference between Clean and Non-clean gascous suppression systems and its
  application; and
- Able to conduct a fire pump flow test using a Pitot tube and its applicable formula.

### Honorary Treasurer's Report

As the Honorary Treasurer for the Session 2011/2012, it is my honour to be able to present to you the audited account of the Institution for the financial period ending 31st. March 2012. The audited account consists of the Auditor's report, Balance Sheet, Income and Expenditure Account and the Notes to the Accounts. These are for your information, attention and scrutiny, if required.

The financial health of the Institution remained strong as we recorded a surplus for the corresponding period yet again. The total income recorded for the period was RM 119,166.84 against total expenditure of RM 87,186.75 which gave a surplus of RM 31,980.09.

Subsidies from Headquarters and surplus from organized courses during the period were the top two contributors of the income with amount of RM 64,055 and RM 41,474.75 respectively. These subsidies were deposited into our account in two installments amounting to RM 34,230 and RM 29,825 for 2<sup>rd</sup> half of 2011 and 1<sup>st</sup> half of 2012 respectively. These amount were much less than the amount reflected in the previous financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2011 amounting to RM84,038.00 which were actually the total subsidy received in three installments for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> half of 2010 and 1<sup>st</sup> half of 2011.

Expenditures incurred during the financial period were mainly for the administrative expenses amounting to RM 83,735.10.

I wish to record my thanks and appreciation to fellow Committee members and the secretariat of IEM (Sarawak Branch) for the contribution, hard work and cooperation. Special thanks also goes to our internal auditors, Ir. Tan Tai Kang and Ir. Chan Hua Tack who had consented to spend their time in going through the audited account.

Finally, I would like to request for your kind consent to accept this audited account presented.

# REPORT ON PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF IEM SARAWAK INTERNATIONAL ENGINEERING CENTRE AT KOTA SAMARAHAN, SARAWAK

### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

It has been a very long way for IEM Sarawak Branch to materialise the development of the proposed International Engineering Centre(IntEC) at Kota Samarahan since it was launched by YAB Ketua Menteri Sarawak, Pehin Sri Haji Abdul Taib Bun Mahmud on 22nd July 2002 at the opening ceremony of the World Engineering Congress 2002 held in Kuching, Sarawak. This paper aims to provide a short report on the development of IntEC over a period of almost 10 years since its inception.

#### 2.0 LAND ISSUE

The ownership of the land located at Lot 10735 Block 59 Muara Tuang Land District(6 acres) was granted to IEM Sarawak Branch by the state government of Sarawak vides Land and Surveys Department of Sarawak's letter of reference 9/HQ/AL/12/2008(8D) dated 30th September 2011 subject to the following terms and condition:

Land Premium: RM556,650.00

Annual land rent: RM1,237.00

Survey fees: RM803.00

Land title fees: RM6.00

Land tenure: 60 years

Special terms and condition:

- (i) This land is to be used only for engineering centre purposes;
- (ii) The development or re-development of this land shall be in accordance with plans sections and elevations approved by the Superintendent of Lands and Surveys, Samarahan Division:
- (iii) The erection of a building or buildings on this land shall be in accordance with the detailed drawing and specifications approved by the Samarahan District Council and shall be completed within two(2) years from the date of registration of this lease and
- (iv) No dealing affecting this land may be effected without the consent in writing of the Minister for the time being responsible for land.
- 60 days notice given to IEMSB after the date of the letter(30th November 2011) to response and accept the offer has already lapsed. An appeal letter requesting for time extention and reduction in land premium was forwarded to the department concerned which is pending approval.

### 3.0 DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Various proposals on the development plan had been discussed by the branch's Standing Committee on IntEC as follows:

### 3.1 Proposal 1

- Based on the model launched by YAB Ketua Menteri Sarawak on 22nd July 2002
- Cost estimate: RM60 mil
- IntEC Building Fund launched by YAB Ketua Menteri Sarawak on 9th December 2005 in conjunction with 37th IEMSB Annual Dinner, announced RM500,000.00 government matching grant, RM16,000.00 donated by corporate entities.

#### 3.2 Proposal 2

- Centre of Excellence For Renewal Energy(Unimas)
- Cost estimate: RM50 mil

### 3.3 Proposal 3

Training centre for human capital for SCORE(technical courses)

### 3.4 Proposal 4

 Shoplots and corporate offices(To appoint land developer, proceeds to IEMSB based on cash and kind)

### 3.5 Proposal 5

- Technical college(on lease/rental to SDC Sarawak/International Centre of Advance Technology Sarawak(i-CATS)
  - Awaiting appointment to discuss in detail with SDC/i-CATS on MOU etc.

As Proposal 5 seems more conducive and approperiate to IEMSB in meeting the objective of bthe development further discussion with SDC/i-CATS will be organised in due course.

### 4.0 CONCLUSION

The mission of IntEC is to realize the development of the project based on the original objective of the development, ie for engineering centre. IEM Sarawak Branch wishes to seek the full support of the state government of Sarawak, corporate bodies in the construction and training industries as well as the IEM for the realization of this imporant project.
