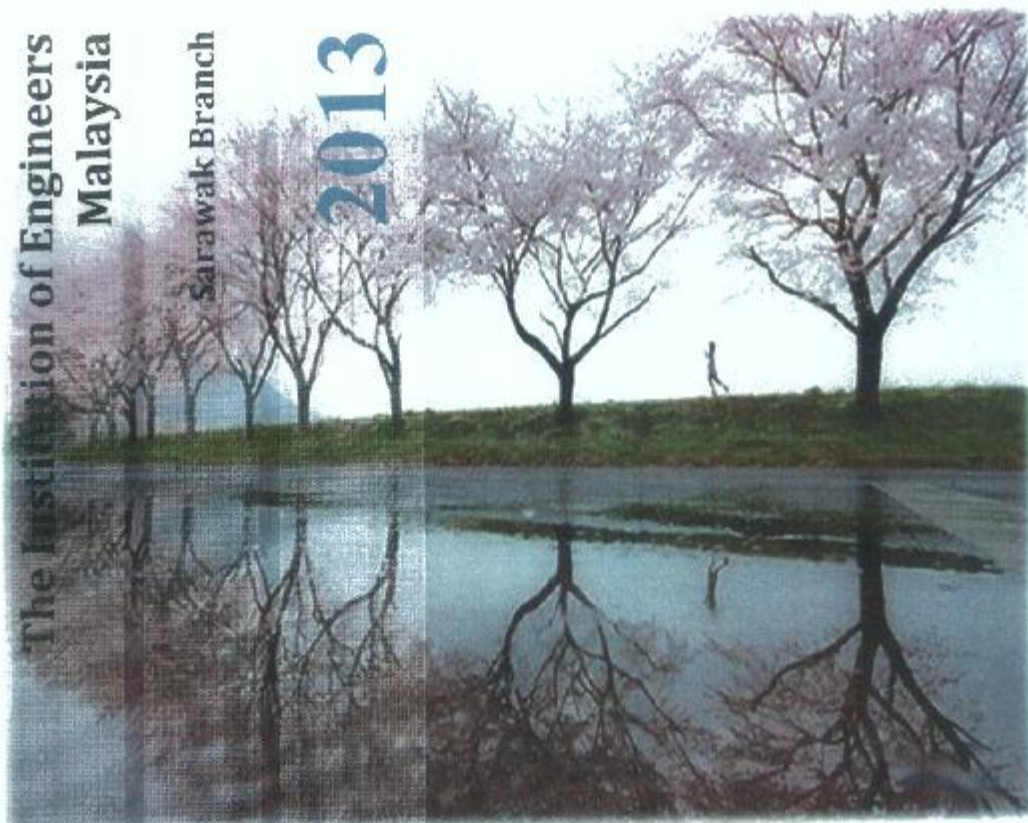

2.0 SNAPSHOTS OF BRANCH ACTIVITIES & EVENTS FOR SESSION 2012/2013

The branch reported that during the session, it had organized the following activities:

2.1 16-17 April 2012

Contract Administration for Construction & Engineering Contracts

Conducted by Harban Singh K.S at Pullman Hotel, Kuching. This seminar has attracted 63 engineers. Course objectives are namely,

- a) To familiarize participants with the various types of Construction/Engineering Contract Procurement Method used.
- b) To understand the right and duties of the various parties under the contract especially the Main and Sub-Contractors.
- c) To learn all aspects of administering the contract from commencement up to the issue of the Final Certificate.
- d) To acquaint with the practical issues involved in the day-to-day running of a contract.
- e) To arm you with effective ways of managing time and cost related claims.
- f) To have a thorough understanding of the various means of avoiding delays, disputes and cost overruns.

2.2 16-18 April 2012

Protection and Commissioning of Power Transformer

This course is jointly organized with Sarawak Energy Bhd. Presented by Ir. Lee Chong Kiow; mainly for the benefit of all engineers and other technical staff who are interested in enhancing their appreciation of this basic and exciting aspect of power system protection and commissioning of transformers.

Power System protection Course

This course attempted to answer many questions in an electrical engineer's mind by describing various concepts of power system protection. Which scope includes all the main components and types of protections schemes. It also describes practical protection schemes; intended for consulting, design, and operation and maintenance engineers responsible for medium and high voltage transmission, distribution, both industrial and commercial power systems. Participants are expected to pre equipped with basic knowledge of power system practices.

2.8 23 June 2012

Changing the Project Management Paradigm

Mr. Phil Palmer, Managing Director of PCSS Consultancy Sdn Bhd (PCSS) conducted this talk, by providing a solid framework base on PMBOK to establish the required methodologies that assist in promoting project success before embarking upon any Effective Project Management software training.

Conducted by Ir. Haji Ahmad Nazri at Auditorium, UPC. The attendance recorded 39 engineers from various disciplines. The objectives of the course are as follows:

- v. To give information on the elements of safe systems of work.



2.13 12 & 13 September 2012
Fundamental Project Management

Ir. Frankie Chong conducted this 2-day course at Auditorium, UPC. The attendance recorded 42 engineers from various disciplines. The benefits for this course are as appended:

- i. Master fundamental project management knowledge, skills, concepts, tools & technique with cross reference to world class standard in USA-based Project Management Institute's Body of Knowledge, PMBOK.
- ii. Understand & apply the best practices in Initiating, Planning, Monitoring and Controlling, Executing, and Closing phases of a Project Life Cycle.
- iii. Justify project & link project goals and objective to stakeholders' needs.
- iv. Identify the critical role & functions of project managers.
- v. Avoid costly mistakes by gaining an insight into the success & failure factors of projects & the advantages of Project Management.
- vi. Enhance management skills in leading, motivating, communicating & resolving conflicts.
- vii. Be more confident in forecasting time & cost of project completion.
- viii. Develop SMART Objective, Work Breakdown Structure, Quality Objective, and Project Plan & Schedule.
- ix. Develop network diagrams to analysis Critical Path & compress project duration.
- x. Estimate project costs, schedules & budget using simple, proven techniques.
- xi. Assess & mitigate project risks.
- xii. Terminating project with Post Implementation Review & lessons learned.
- xiii. Networks with other participants & share valuable experiences.

Engineering Week 2012 :Comprehensive and Balance Engineers

Conducted at Faculty of Engineering, University Malaysia Sarawak (UNIMAS) by IEM UNIMAS Student Chapter.

2.15 10 October 2012

Black Box of Infrastructure Software (using Infravera V2.2 with MSMA2)

Engr. Chee Shai Choon & Mr. Lin We Shen had presented this half day course to disclose to participants in understanding how the said software work. With this BLACK BOX of civil engineering software (Infrastructure Design); where a number of issues have been raised up to by sharing of examples to enlighten participants. It had help to equip and strengthen engineers with more knowledge on engineering applications. The attendance has recorded a number of 47 engineers participation.



2.16 16-18 October 2012 & 27-29 November 2012

Design and Practice of Earthing Course

This 3-day course was jointly organized with Sarawak Energy Bhd and presented by Ir. Thum Peng Chew.

The purpose of this course is to give an overview of the function of electrical earthing in a power system. It covered the general & fundamental characteristics of parameters that influence the flow of earth currents & the earth resistance value.

The functions & behaviours of the various types of earths e.g. lightning, neutral & frame as well as electronic application. The course has explained the electrical shock criterion, shock situations & traces the development of earthing grid design. It then gave an introduction to the EMC problem that is now becoming a critical issue in computer control of the power system especially in the substation and industrial plant.

The participants have been enlightened with a wider knowledge base & appreciation of the basis for designing an earthing system from experience of actual hands-on exercises conducted during the course.

2.17 4-5 December 2012

Technical Talk on MSMA 2nd Edition Using MES Software

This 2day Seminar was presented by Prof. Dr. Nor Azazi Zakaria, Engr. Chang Chun Kiat & Engr. Leow Cheng Siang

This seminar has introduced participants to the application of the latest urban drainage procedure gazette by the Government in 2012. This "Urban Stormwater Management Manual for Malaysia @ MSMA 2nd Edition" was published by the Department of Irrigation and Drainage. Also, the seminar has provided C & S consultants an insight into how the latest civil software applications could improve and simplify the design process. By mastering these userfriendly & straight forward software, design engineers may save up to 80% computation time. Topics that had been elaborated include BIOECOD System, OSD & Detention Pond and also JPS Plan Submission base on MSMA 2nd Edition.



2.18 8 December 2012

Overview on Professional Engineers' Interview 2012

2.19 15 December 2012

Revisiting the Mandatory Skills of a Civil Engineer in Geotechnical Works

The branch has organized this 1day Seminar by inviting Ir. Dr. Gue See Sew to restore this mandatory skill to 49 civil engineers at Auditorium, UPC.

The seminar has covered areas such as:

- ii. Site Investigation & Site Investigation Interpretation on Soft Ground
- iii. Ground Treatments in Soft Ground



2.20 8th March 2013

IEM Arbitration Rules (2012) & Contractual and Statutory "Adjudication" Understanding the Main Differences

Ir. C.K.Khoo presented on this 1day Seminar covering topics such as:

i. IEM Arbitration Rules (2012)

The IEM Arbitration Rules (2003) have been in use since November 2003. Since then the Arbitration Act 2005 had been enacted and became effective on 15 March 2006, superseding Act 1952.

The IEM Rules (2012) is a revised version of the Rules (2003), with amendments to improve upon the 2003 Rules with the objective of savings in time and cost of the arbitral proceedings, as well as to conform to the 2005 Act. Revision is made to 7 (seven) of the 2003 Rules.

ii. Contractual and Statutory Adjudication : Understanding the Main Differences

In 1999, FIDIC introduced contractual "Adjudication" in its "red book", i.e. "Condition of Contract for Construction for the Building and Engineer Works Designed by the Employer". In the same year such contractual "adjudication" was also introduced in the other FIDIC form of Contract, viz, the yellow, silver, and the green books.

Statutory "adjudication" was introduced in several Commonwealth countries and states of Australia, viz, UK (1996), New Zealand (2002), and Singapore (2004) and in Australia: New South Wales (1999), Victoria (2002) and Queensland (2004).

In 2012, the Construction Industry Payment and Adjudication Act (CIPAA) was passed by Parliament in Malaysia and gazetted as Law on 22 June 2012.

There are significant differences between contractual "adjudication" (as prescribed in the provision and practices in FIDIC) and the statutory provisions under CIPAA. This seminar has explored the main differences and gave a general understanding of how the two systems of "adjudication" operate, hence how each system affects dispute management in construction contracts.

The seminar has recorded 34 participants.



2.21 9th March 2013

Dispute Management in Construction Contracts: Red Sea, Blue Ocean or Green Valley?

On the second day, Ir. C.K. Khoo continued to present a Half-Day Seminar and attracted 30 participants.

In this seminar he covered various topics. Construction Contracts are often bedeviled by disputes over Quality of Work, Payment, Time and Cost Issues. In serious cases, parties are so mired in disputes that they lose sight of the objective of the Contract, viz : to carry out the proper construction of the Works, and with each Party honoring its commitments in accordance with the Contract.

Disputes may be resolved mainly by Negotiation, Mediation, Adjudication, Arbitration or Litigation, and variants of such methods such as Dispute Resolution Advisors, Dispute Adjudication Boards, Fast Track Arbitration, Arb-Med or Med-Arb. The range of methods is ever-growing, as the construction industry finds the existing (contentious) methods to be unsatisfactory and wasteful in time and cost.



2.22 26th -27th March 2013

Design of Sprinkler Systems-MS1910, NFPA13 & NFPA15 Water Spray System

Ir. Gary Lim Eng Hwa was invited to conduct this 2day Course at Auditorium, Ultimate Professional Centre. The course was attended by 16 engineers.

At the end of the training course, participants would be able to:

- i. Understand the history of sprinkler and it's development to modern time.
- ii. Understand that a discount of 40% of insurance premium for sprinkler system installation allowed under PIAM guidelines.
- iii. Know the types of sprinkler heads and its application.
- iv. Understand the various sprinkler standards used in the industry, MS1910 and NFPA 13 and 15, the major differences.
- v. Understand the various sprinkler systems available to meet certain situation or application.
- vi. Apply the Fundamental of Fluid Dynamics on a case study to determine pipe size and pump capacity.
- vii. Able to design Pre-Calculated System for Ordinary Hazard, High Hazard Storage and In-Rack Sprinkler systems.
- viii. Able to design Full Hydraulic calculation for Yard Transformers and LPG Refilling area.



2.23 Overall, a total of 219 CPD hours has been organized for the session of 2012/13.

Honorary Treasurer's Report

In a remark made during our 31st AGM by the Past President of IEM in 1999, he urged the Institution to be more entrepreneurially oriented in our approach to enable us organise our activities without relying too much on the annual membership subscriptions to fund our operations. It is still very much relevant to us today especially since we already had acquired the INTEC land which needs big fund to finance and commence with the building works.

Additional staffs were employed to join the Secretariat since 2012 to help streamline the overall financial aspects of our operation. From the financial perspectives, immediate positive outcomes can be seen with a RM73,435.97 surplus recorded from the organised courses, probably our highest ever, replacing the subsidy from IEM HQ amounting RM63,656.50 as the top income earner for the period. Our overall financial position remained strong as the Operating Income recorded was RM152,117.28 against Operating Expenditure of RM 120,250.72 for the year with a surplus of RM31,866.56 which was almost identical to last year figure. Administrative expenses of RM83,129.22 was recorded, almost unchanged from last year despite having more Secretariat staff.

The total expenditure also included the RM 18,599.60 as the final adjustment for the Bamboo to Broadband Book Project, thus considerably reducing the year's overall surplus. It was necessarily done due to the book sales were overtaken up at one time and also to take into account the final outstanding amount of the RM 50,000 loan in total taken from IEM HQ in 1999 and 2000 to finance the Book Project which were previously not projected as one item by itself under the Current Liabilities in the Balance Sheet, in prior years since 2001. IEM HQ only confirmed recently this year that the loan's final outstanding amount was RM49,950. However, the remaining 441 copies of the book stock as of 31.3.13, once all sold at RM88/copy, shall be worth RM38,808 which could be used to pay off major portion of the loan.

We finally managed to get hold of our 6 acres of INTEC land in Kota Samarahan after land premium amount of RM556,650 was paid to the Sarawak Government in March 2013 which was funded by the RM 500,000 loan received early this year from IEM HQ and the balance from our own fund. The land was included in the Balance Sheet as an additional property valued at its land premium cost.

I wish to record my thanks and appreciation to fellow Excors, Secretariat and our Internal Auditors for their contributions, hard work and cooperation. And finally, I present here the audited account for the financial period ending 31st March 2013 consisting of the Auditor's Report, Balance Sheet, Income and Expenditure Account and the Notes to the Accounts for your kind perusal and acceptance, please.





1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- (a) **Basis of preparation**
The financial statements of the Institute have been prepared under the historical cost convention.
- (b) **Depreciation & property, plant & equipment**
It is the past practice of the Institution not to provide for depreciation of property, plant & equipment. Those property, plant & equipment are taken up at cost. The increase in property, plant & equipment is due to purchase of air-conditioner and short leasehold land.

Payables are stated at cost which is the fair value of the consideration to be paid in the future for goods and services received.
- (e) **Revenue recognition**
Revenue represents sales at invoiced value.

REPORT ON PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF IEM SARAWAK INTERNATIONAL ENGINEERING CENTRE AT KOTA SAMARAHAN, SARAWAK

1.0 INTRODUCTION

It has been a very long way for IEM Sarawak Branch to materialise the development of the proposed International Engineering Centre (IntEC) at Kota Samarahan since it was launched by YAB Ketua Menteri Sarawak, Pehin Sri Haji Abdul Taib Bin Mahmud on 22nd July 2002 at the opening ceremony of the World Engineering Congress 2002 held in Kuching, Sarawak. This paper aims to provide a short report on the development of IntEC over a period of almost 10 years since its inception.

2.0 LAND ISSUE

The ownership of the land located at Lot 10735 Block 59 Muara Tuang Land District (6 acres) was granted to IEM Sarawak Branch by the state government of Sarawak vide Land and Surveys Department of Sarawak's letter of reference 9/HQ/AL/12/2008(8D) dated 30th September 2011 subject to the following terms and condition:

Land Premium: RM558,850.00

Annual land rent: RM1,237.00

Survey fees: RM803.00

Land title fees: RM8.00

Land tenure: 60 years

Special terms and condition:

(i) This land is to be used only for engineering centre purposes;

(ii) The development or re-development of this land shall be in accordance with plans, sections and elevations approved by the Superintendent of Lands and Surveys, Samarahan Division;

(iii) The erection of a building or buildings on this land shall be in accordance with the detailed drawing and specifications approved by the Samarahan District Council and shall be completed within two (2) years from the date of registration of this lease and

(iv) No dealing affecting this land may be effected without the consent in writing of the Minister for the time being responsible for land.

60 days notice given to IEMSB after the date of the letter (30th November 2011) to response and accept the offer has already lapsed. An appeal letter requesting for time extension and reduction in land premium was forwarded to the department concerned which is pending approval.

3.0 DEVELOPMENT PLAN

REVISED BUSINESS PLAN NO.2

INTRODUCTION

IEMSB noted that the request/advise by YAB Chief Minister is not conducive with the existing of so many technical training providers providing human capacity building programme for SCORE namely International Centre of Advance Training Sarawak(ICATS), Laila Taib College, Institut Latihan Perindustrian(ILP), Institut Kemahiran MARA(IKM), Youth Training Centre etc. In order not to duplicate what others are doing IEMSB has come up with a proposed concept planning based on a win-win basis together with a land developer without any monetary burden or minimum investment on IEMSB.

PROPOSED NEW CONCEPT AND IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

PLAN A

Proposed that 2 acres out of 6-acre land to be developed into 2 rows of 8 units of 3-4 storey of shophouses with IEMSB occupying a unit as IEMSB headquarters. The remaining 4 acres to be developed with a few rows of shophouses of different design as corporate offices for engineers such as engineering consultants, Research and Development engineers, contractors, suppliers and the like.

PLAN B

Proposed that 3 acres out of 6-acre land at frontage to be developed for corporate offices for engineers with businesses as described in Plan A above with the remaining 3 acres reserved for IEMSB as its headquarters and for future development.

The design of the proposed project will adopt the latest requirement/technology with the state of art of engineering design vis-à-vis Green Building Index(GBI), renewal energy and MSMA.

The IEMSB headquarters shall include the necessary facilities and not limited to such as Secretariat, lecture hall(CPD), resource centre(library), computer laboratories(ICT), research laboratories, engineering museum and recreational facilities.

IEMSB shall call for development proposal from 3 selected project developers to cover scope of works as below:

1. Prepare planning submission to SPA for approval
2. Pay land premium to Land and Survey Department
3. Prepare development/business plan for IEMSB's approval
4. Provide all funding for the necessary construction and completion of the development to local council's approval
5. Handover shophouse unit to IEMSB for its corporate office.
6. Perform any other duties as project developer

Prior to the appointment of a project developer IEMSB to elaborate on the new business plan in its Executive Committee meeting soon. An Extra Ordinary Meeting would be called latter to discuss and agree on the proposed new development plan and to give mandate to the IEMSB Executive Committee to plan and implement the project.
